

Not enough ports to connect a splitter

If you don't have enough Ethernet ports, using a network switch is generally a better solution than a splitter, as splitters are limited in speed and device support.

Why a Splitter May Not Work

Ethernet splitters are designed to combine two connections into one cable by using the unused wires in a 10/100 Mbps Ethernet cable. They only work for two devices per cable and cannot handle Gigabit speeds (10/100/1000 Mbps) because Gigabit Ethernet uses all eight wires for data transmission . Additionally, splitters do not increase the total number of available ports—they merely allow two devices to share a single cable, which can cause connectivity issues if more devices are connected than the splitter supports .

Limitations of Splitters

- Device Limit: Each splitter can only handle two devices per cable .
- Speed Restriction: Works only with 10/100 Mbps networks; Gigabit Ethernet is incompatible .
- No Power over Ethernet (PoE): Splitters cannot transmit PoE because they use only four of the eight wires .
- Potential Signal Issues: Using multiple splitters or connecting more devices than supported can cause signal degradation or “unplugged” errors .
