

OPGW Optical Cable Fusion Splicing Solution

OPGW fusion splicing requires precise fiber preparation, careful removal of metallic layers, fusion with a splicer, and secure protection in closures to maintain both optical and grounding functions.

Overview of OPGW Cables

OPGW cables combine grounding and communication functions, housing optical fibers within a metallic conductor for high-voltage transmission lines. Common types include Central Tube (OPGW C/CA), Aluminum Pipe (OPGW AP), and Stranded Type (OPGW S), each with fibers housed in stainless steel, aluminum, or PVC tubes. These cables are installed above power conductors to protect against lightning while providing telecommunication capabilities.

Preparation and Safety

- Establish an equal potential zone using temporary ground cables, conductive mats, and removable hot-sticks to prevent electrical hazards.
- Stretch and mark the cable over 2-2.5 meters, wrapping tape at the marking points to secure strands during cutting.
- Remove metallic layers carefully:
- Use a metal saw or mini grinder to cut aluminum strands circumferentially.
- Unwrap and remove outer and inner stranded wires.
- For metal loose tubes, inner strands should extend ~10 mm longer than outer strands to expose the fiber tubes
