

Optical power of the switch s optical port



Article Overview

The optical power emitted from a switch's optical port, known as TX (Transmit) power, is the strength of the light signal leaving the SFP or optical transceiver, typically measured in dBm.

Understanding TX Power

TX power represents the amount of optical signal generated by the transceiver and sent into the fiber cable. It is a critical metric for ensuring reliable fiber optic communication, as insufficient TX power can lead to weak signals at the receiving end, while excessive power can damage the receiver (ROSA) on the remote device . TX power is measured in decibel-milliwatts (dBm), where 0 dBm equals 1 milliwatt of optical power. Typical values for short-range SFP modules are often in the range of -1 to -7 dBm, while long-haul or high-power modules may have higher output .

Monitoring and Measurement

There are two main ways to check TX power:

- **Switch-Based Monitoring (DOM/DDM):** Many modern SFP modules support Digital Optical Monitoring (DOM), allowing the switch to report real-time TX and RX power directly via CLI commands. For example, on Cisco Catalyst switches, the command `show interfaces transceiver detail` displays TX power along with RX power and threshold warnings .
- **Optical Power Meter:** A direct measurement tool that connects to the fiber end face to measure the actual optical power emitted. This is commonly used for on-site verification and troubleshooting
