

Outgoing line cabinet circuit and distribution box circuit

The outgoing line cabinet circuit distributes power from the distribution box to individual loads, while the distribution box circuit manages incoming power, protection, and distribution to multiple outgoing circuits.

Distribution Box Circuit

A distribution box (or distribution board) is the central point where the main power supply is received and distributed to multiple loads. It contains all the switching and protective devices, such as MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers), RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers), fuses, and isolators . The distribution box circuit is divided into:

- Incoming line part: Receives power from the main supply, which can be a single line or multiple lines (e.g., normal and backup supply). It includes the incoming circuit breaker, which protects against overcurrent and short circuits .
- Dual power switch (if applicable): Automatically switches to a backup supply if the main supply fails, ensuring continuity of power .
- Outgoing line circuits: Each outgoing circuit connects to a specific load or group of loads, with its own protective devices to ensure safe operation .
