A Gigabit PoE switch delivers both data at 1 Gbps and electrical power over Ethernet cables, typically following IEEE 802.3af (PoE) or IEEE 802.3at (PoE+) standards.

Overview of PoE Gigabit Switches

A PoE Gigabit switch combines high-speed data transmission with power delivery over a single Ethernet cable, allowing devices like IP cameras, wireless access points, and VoIP phones to operate without separate power adapters . Gigabit switches provide 1 Gbps data rates on each port, which is the standard for modern LAN networks .

PoE Standards

- IEEE 802.3af (PoE): Delivers up to 15.4 watts per port, suitable for low-power devices.
- IEEE 802.3at (PoE+): Delivers up to 30 watts per port, supporting higher-power devices like PTZ cameras or multi-radio access points .
- 4PPoE (IEEE 802.3bt): Uses all four pairs of wires to provide even higher power (up to 60-100 watts per port), though this is less common in standard Gigabit switches .

Key Features

- Port Configuration: Common models include 8, 16, or 24 Gigabit RJ45 ports, often with additional SFP slots for fiber uplinks .
- Power Budget: Each switch has a total PoE power budget (e.g., 124W for 8 PoE+ p...
