- **Avoid Overloading:** Do not operate relays beyond their rated contact or coil specifications. Overvoltage or incorrect wiring can cause insulation failure, contact welding, or fire .
- **Environmental Considerations:** Ensure relays are suitable for the installation environment. Avoid atmospheres with explosive gases, excessive dust, or moisture unless the relay is specifically rated for such conditions .
- **Mechanical Handling:** Do not drop or dismantle relays, as physical damage can reduce performance or cause internal faults .
- **Wiring and Soldering:** Follow manufacturer wiring diagrams precisely. Defective wiring or soldering can lead to abnormal heating or relay failure .

Operational and Testing Precautions

- **Compatibility and Selection:** Choose relays appropriate for the system's voltage, current, and environmental conditions. Verify that the relay type matches the protection requirements and mounting conditions
