Sealing Methods

- **Heat-Shrink Sealing:** Uses a material that contracts when heated to form a tight, waterproof seal around the fiber splice. It is durable, weather-resistant, and provides long-term reliability, though it limits access for maintenance once sealed .
- **Mechanical Sealing:** Employs clamps or screws to secure the closure housing. This method is suitable for environments where occasional access is needed and provides a strong barrier against environmental factors .
- **Sealant Strips and Gaskets:** Inserted into grooves of the closure, these provide additional protection for unused ports and ensure a snug fit to prevent ingress of contaminants
