

Red incoming wire from the distribution box



Article Overview

A red incoming wire in a distribution box typically represents a live (phase) wire carrying power from the utility to the main terminal of the panel.

Purpose of the Red Wire

The red wire is usually one of the hot or live wires that brings electrical power from the utility service into the distribution box or main panel . In single-phase systems, it carries 120V (in the US) or 230V (in many other countries) relative to neutral, while in split-phase or multi-phase systems, it may be one of two or more live wires supplying different phases . Its main role is to feed the main circuit breaker, which then distributes power to branch circuits safely .

Proper Connection

- **Main Terminal:** The red wire should be securely connected to the main terminal or main breaker input inside the distribution box .
- **Circuit Breakers:** From the main breaker, power is routed to individual branch breakers, which protect each circuit from overloads .
- **Labeling:** Clearly mark the red wire as a live wire to prevent confusion during maintenance or future upgrades .
- **Torque and Safety:** Ensure all connections are tightened to manufacturer specifications using a calibrated wrench, and avoid exposing bare copper beyond the terminal .
