Key Considerations for Fiber-Compatible Routers

WAN Port Type: Most fiber connections terminate at an ONT, which converts optical signals to Ethernet. Routers with 1 Gbps or multi-gigabit WAN ports can connect directly to the ONT for full fiber speeds . Some advanced routers, like the ASUS RT-BE96U, include dual 10 Gbps WAN/LAN ports for high-speed fiber plans .

Wi-Fi Standards: To maximize fiber speeds, routers supporting Wi-Fi 6 (AX) or Wi-Fi 7 are recommended. Wi-Fi 7 routers, such as the Netgear Nighthawk RS700S, deliver faster speeds and better performance for multiple devices, gaming, and UHD streaming .

Coverage and Device Support: Consider the size of your home or office and the number of devices. High-end routers like the RS700S can cover up to 3,500 square feet and support 200 devices simultaneously . Mesh systems, such as the Linksys Velop AX4200, are ideal for eliminating dead zones in larger spaces .

LAN Ports: For wired connections, ensure the router has sufficient Ethernet ports. Many fiber routers offer 4 or more LAN ports, with some models providing 2.5G or 10G ports for NAS setups or high-speed workstations .
