A single-mode fiber optic port is a network interface designed to transmit and receive data over single-mode fiber, supporting long-distance, high-speed communication using laser light.

Overview

A single-mode fiber optic port is typically found on network devices such as switches, routers, and media converters. It allows the connection of single-mode fiber (SMF), which has a small core diameter of approximately 9 microns and a cladding diameter of 125 microns, enabling only one mode of light to propagate. This design minimizes modal dispersion, allowing data to travel over long distances with very low signal loss.

How It Works

The port works in conjunction with single-mode SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) transceivers, which convert electrical signals from the device into optical signals and vice versa. These transceivers typically operate at 1310nm or 1550nm wavelengths, using laser light to transmit data efficiently over distances ranging from 2 km up to 120 km, depending on the module type and optical power budget. The port is hot-swappable, meaning the SFP module can be replaced without powering down the device.
