Article Overview

Secondary electrical distribution boxes (subpanels) in residential or commercial rooms typically range from 12×12×4 inches for small panels to 24×36×6 inches for larger subpanels, depending on the number of circuits and amperage.

Physical Dimensions

For standard residential applications, subpanels are generally wall-mounted breaker boxes that receive power from the main service panel. Typical dimensions vary based on capacity:

- Small subpanels (60–100A): approximately 12–14 inches wide, 12–16 inches high, and 4–5 inches deep. These are suitable for a few branch circuits in a single room or small area .
- Medium subpanels (100–150A): around 16–20 inches wide, 20–24 inches high, and 4–6 inches deep, accommodating more circuits and larger wire sizes .
- Large subpanels (200A or more): can reach 24–36 inches wide, 30–36 inches high, and 6 inches deep, often used in commercial or high-demand residential areas with multiple circuits, EV chargers, or HVAC systems . Multi-gang junction boxes for outlets or switches in each room are smaller, typically 4×4 inches for single-gang, 6×4 inches for double-gang, and 8×4 inches for triple-gang, with depths ranging from 1.5 to 3.5 inches depending on wire fill requirements
