

Standard Requirements for Leakage Protection of Distribution Boxes



Article Overview

Leakage protection in distribution boxes is primarily governed by IEC 61439-3:2024, requiring residual current devices (RCDs) with specific rated leakage currents and tripping times depending on the application and environment.

Key Standards and Requirements

IEC 61439-3:2024 defines requirements for distribution boards intended to be operated by ordinary persons, including the integration of leakage protection devices to prevent electric shock and fire hazards . Leakage protection is typically implemented using Residual Current Devices (RCDs), which detect imbalances between phase and neutral currents and disconnect the circuit when leakage exceeds a set threshold .

Rated Leakage Current and Tripping Time

- Main distribution box: The RCD should have a rated leakage current of 50–100 mA with a tripping time greater than 0.1 seconds .
- Switch boxes or subsidiary distribution boxes: The RCD should have a rated leakage current not exceeding 30 mA, with a tripping time less than 0.1 seconds. In wet or damp locations, the rated leakage current should be ≤ 15 mA with the same tripping time limit . These parameters ensure rapid disconnection in case of leakage, minimizing the risk of electric shock, especially in environments with higher moisture or human contact....
