Aggregation switches use link aggregation, Layer 2/3 switching, high-speed backplanes, and advanced routing protocols to consolidate and manage network traffic efficiently.

### Core Technologies

**Link Aggregation:** Aggregation switches commonly use Link Aggregation Control Protocol (LACP) or static link aggregation to combine multiple physical links into a single logical connection. This increases bandwidth, provides redundancy, and enables load balancing across links, preventing any single connection from becoming a bottleneck . **Layer 2 and Layer 3 Switching:** These switches operate at Layer 2 (switching) and Layer 3 (routing) of the OSI model. Layer 2 features include VLAN support, Spanning Tree Protocol (STP) variants like RSTP and MSTP for loop prevention, and multicast/broadcast control. Layer 3 capabilities allow routing between VLANs and support for protocols such as OSPF and BGP . **High-Speed Backplane and Port Density:** Aggregation switches are designed with high-speed backplanes and ample port density to handle large volumes of traffic from multiple access switches. They often support 10 Gbps, 40 Gbps, or even 100 Gbps uplinks to core switches, ensuring minimal latency and high throughput . **Quality of Service (QoS) and Traffic Management:** These switches implement QoS policies to prioritize critical traffic, manage congestion, and ensure efficient load balancing across aggregated links. They also support IP address translation and traffic filtering for security and performance optimization . **Modular and Scalable Design:** Many aggreg...
