Immediate Safety Measures

- Examine the mounting area in the distribution box to ensure screws or DIN rail clips are intact and not damaged ().

Reinstallation or Replacement

- Remove the switch completely if it is partially attached.
- Install the same model or a compatible replacement to ensure proper voltage, current rating, and mechanical fit ().
- Secure the switch using screws or DIN rail clips according to the manufacturer's instructions ().
- Reconnect wiring carefully:
- Main circuit: input terminals (R, S, T) to the switch, output terminals to the load....
