Article Overview

A disconnected grounding terminal in a distribution box creates a serious safety hazard, increasing the risk of electric shock, equipment damage, and improper operation of protective devices.

Safety Risks

The grounding terminal provides a low-resistance path for fault currents to safely dissipate into the earth. If it is disconnected, metal parts of electrical equipment can become energized, posing a risk of electrocution to anyone touching them. In a ground fault, current may attempt to return via unintended paths, such as through a person or through other conductive structures, which can be extremely dangerous.

Impact on Electrical Protection

Protective devices like Residual Current Devices (RCDs) or Ground Fault Circuit Interrupters (GFCIs) rely on a proper ground connection to detect leakage currents. Without grounding, these devices may fail to trip during a fault, leaving circuits energized and increasing the risk of fire or shock. Additionally, the absence of a ground can cause voltage fluctuations, dimming lights, or erratic operation of sensitive equipment.
