

Thickness of Molded Galvanized Cable Trays



Article Overview

Molded galvanized cable trays typically have a thickness ranging from 1.0 mm for narrower trays up to 300 mm wide, with thicker sections for wider trays depending on load requirements and standards.

Standard Thickness Ranges

- Narrow trays (up to 300 mm width): Commonly 1.0 mm thick for hot-dip or pre-galvanized steel trays, suitable for light to medium cable loads .
- Wider trays (over 300 mm width): Thickness increases proportionally to maintain mechanical strength and rigidity; typical values range from 1.2 mm to 2.0 mm depending on manufacturer specifications and load ratings .
- Hot-dip galvanized trays: Often slightly thicker than pre-galvanized trays to account for zinc coating and ensure corrosion resistance .
- Electro-galvanized trays: Usually thinner than hot-dip trays but still meet NEMA VE-1 or IEC standards for mechanical and corrosion performance .

Factors Affecting Thickness Selection

- Tray Width and Depth: Wider or deeper trays require thicker steel to prevent excessive deflection under cable load .
- Load Capacity: Heavier cable bundles or high-density installations may require thicker trays to maintain structural integrity .
- Environmental Conditions: Hot-dip galvanization provides a thicker zinc layer, offering better corrosion protection in humid or industrial environments
