

U-shaped fixing of optical cable

U-shaped brackets or clamps are used to securely fix optical cables to walls, poles, or towers, especially when the cable path is perpendicular to the mounting surface.

Purpose and Applications

U-shaped fixings are primarily used to anchor optical cables at suspension points where the cable changes direction or is perpendicular to a wall or pole. They are commonly applied in:

- Wall-mounted installations: When the hanging wire is perpendicular to the wall, U-shaped pull tabs or brackets are used to secure the cable and prevent sagging or stress at the bend points .
- Aerial installations on towers or poles: U-brackets guide optical fiber aerial cables down lattice towers or poles to joint boxes, ensuring proper alignment and stress distribution .
- ADSS (All Dielectric Self-Supporting) cables: U-shaped clamps act as suspension or tension fittings, providing grip and strain relief while maintaining cable integrity .

Installation Method

- Mounting the Bracket: U-shaped brackets are fixed to the wall or pole using expansion bolts or through bolts. For wall installations, M12X100 bolts are used for larger suspension wires, while M10X80 bolts are suitable for smaller cables .
- Securing the Cable: The optical cable is placed inside the U-shaped bracket and clamped using a U-shaped steel wire clamp or a preformed wire suspension grip. Protective backing rings or rubber inserts are often used to prevent bending stress...
