

Unloading of cable trays at the construction site

Cable trays should be unloaded carefully using proper lifting methods, inspected for damage, and stored in a dry, covered area to ensure safety and maintain material integrity.

Preparation and Safety

Before unloading, ensure the work area is clear, safe, and ready for handling the cable trays. Workers should be trained in proper lifting techniques and wear appropriate personal protective equipment, including gloves and steel-toed footwear . Avoid using cable trays as walkways or supports for personnel, as this can cause injury and damage the trays .

Unloading Methods

- Hand Unloading: For smaller trays or when forklifts are not suitable, trays can be hand unloaded. Ensure multiple workers lift evenly to prevent bending or dropping .
- Mechanical Lifting: Use forklifts, cranes, or boom-type equipment for larger trays. Slings or spreaders should be used to distribute weight evenly and prevent damage to the tray edges .
- Skidding: Trays and accessories are often skidded or bundled for easier handling. Ensure bundles are balanced at the center and secured with adequate banding .
