Ferrules can be made from ceramic, plastic, metal, or glass, with ceramic ferrules being the most common due to their precision and stability. The ferrule typically has a cylindrical shape with a central hole for the fiber, ensuring accurate alignment and minimal signal loss .

### Flange and Crimp Sleeve

Some connectors include a flange to hold the ferrule in the housing, and a crimp sleeve made of soft metals like aluminum or brass. The crimp sleeve provides tensile strength, pullout resistance, and strain relief by securing the cable's strength memb...
