

What are the methods for sealing cable trays

Sealing cable trays involves using weatherproofing systems, cable entry seals, and enclosures to protect cables from water, dust, and environmental hazards while maintaining accessibility for future expansion.

Weatherproofing Cable Trays

For vertical wall penetrations, a weatherstop sealing system is commonly used. This may appear as ductwork or boxes attached to the building exterior, creating a sealed entrance for cables. Alternatively, GRP (glass-reinforced plastic) weathering systems can be applied as a cold-applied liquid to seal the tray directly against the wall, providing a waterproof and windproof barrier without additional ductwork. For roof penetrations, service risers or upstands are used to create a structurally sound, waterproof seal. These can be combined with GRP sealants to ensure the tray remains protected from rain and wind while maintaining durability.

Cable Entry Seals

To seal individual cables or multiple cables exiting a tray, cable entry seals are highly effective. These include:

- Grommet seals: Flexible rubber-like seals that fit around individual cables, protecting them from wear and environmental exposure.
- Compression seals: Mechanically tightened seals that create a water-tight fit, idea...
