Electrical distribution box sheds on construction sites must comply with NEC, OSHA, and HSE standards, ensuring proper enclosure, grounding, weatherproofing, and worker safety.

Regulatory Requirements

NEC (National Electrical Code) Article 590 governs temporary electrical installations, including distribution boxes. Key points include:

- Temporary installations must be approved by the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) to ensure safety compliance .
- Equipment must meet permanent installation requirements unless specifically modified for temporary use, such as allowing splices in multiconductor cords without a box .
- Temporary wiring should generally not exceed 90 days unless extended by approval .
- Ground-fault circuit interrupters (GFCIs) are required for receptacles in damp or wet locations . OSHA Standards (29 CFR 1926.405) focus on worker safety:
- All components must be OSHA-approved and rated for industrial use .
- Distribution boxes must be mounted off the ground to prevent water intrusion and reduce shock hazards
