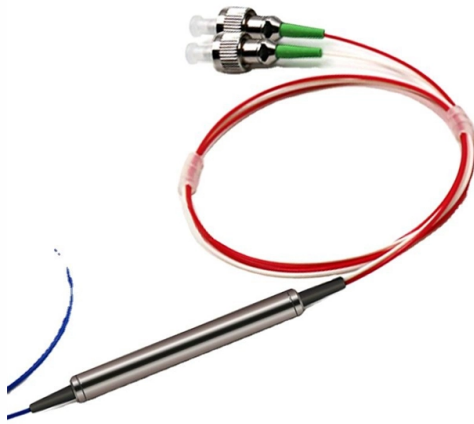


What are the uses of aggregation layer switches

Aggregation layer switches consolidate traffic from multiple access switches, provide high-bandwidth uplinks to core networks, and enhance scalability, redundancy, and network performance.

Central Traffic Consolidation

Aggregation switches sit in the middle tier of a network, collecting traffic from multiple access switches and forwarding it to the core layer. This reduces the number of direct connections to the core, simplifying network design and improving efficiency . They act as a funnel, aggregating data from devices such as PCs, servers, IP phones, and wireless access points into high-speed uplinks .

High Bandwidth and Link Aggregation

These switches support link aggregation protocols like LACP or static link aggregation, combining multiple physical links into a single logical connection. This increases bandwidth, provides redundancy, and allows simultaneous data transmission over multiple paths . Aggregation switches often handle Layer 2 and Layer 3 traffic, enabling VLAN segmentation, routing, and Quality of Service (QoS) management .
