- Splicing: Fibers are joined using fusion or mechanical splicing, with splices protected in trays to prevent damage .
- Patching: Patch cords are used to cross-connect fibers, enabling flexible routing from transceivers to output ports .
- Distribution: Fibers are routed to their final destinations, such as from a central office to residential or business endpoints .
