- **Prevention of Sparking:** Electrical connections are mechanically stable, with terminals and wires secured to prevent loosening or vibration-induced sparks. Special terminal technologies, such as screw or spring terminals, are used to ensure reliable connections .
- **Temperature Control:** Materials and construction are selected to ensure that surface temperatures remain below the ignition point of surrounding gases or dusts, even under maximum load. Cooling measures may be incorporated to dissipate heat effectively .
- **Mechanical Stability:** Components are protected against mechanical damage, corrosion, and environmental influences. Enclosures are robust and often rated for high ingress protection (e.g., IP66) to prevent water and dust ingress ....
