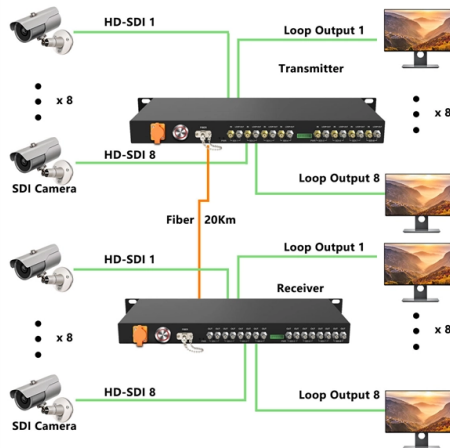


What is the iron core in the middle of an optical cable called
