

What is the spacing between suspended mesh cable trays



Article Overview

The typical support spacing for suspended mesh cable trays ranges from 1.5 meters to 3 meters, depending on load, cable type, and environmental conditions.

Horizontal and Vertical Spacing

For suspended mesh cable trays, the distance between supports (brackets or hangers) is critical to prevent sagging and maintain system integrity. The recommended support span for horizontal runs is generally 1.5 to 3 meters . This ensures stability, allows for proper cable management, and facilitates maintenance access. For vertical runs, the same spacing can be applied for runs angled more than 30 degrees from vertical, while steeper vertical runs may require closer support or strain relief sections .

Parallel Tray Spacing

When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the minimum horizontal spacing should be 0.6 meters. This clearance allows for maintenance, inspection, airflow for heat dissipation, and reduces the risk of cables touching or short-circuiting . For power and signal cable trays, a separation of 0.5 meters is recommended to minimize electromagnetic interference, which can be reduced further to 0.3 meters if the trays are shielded .
