Recommended for outdoor use if protected against weather influences GRP – GLASS FIBRE REINFORCED POLYESTER Polycarbonate and ABS enclosure materials. The fiber optic splice closure is a closed structure used for splicing, protecting and managing optical fibers. The fiber optic heat shrink tubes is tight and the metal support maintains its strength to prevent the fiber from breaking at the splice.
