Common stainless steel grades include 304 and 316, with 316 offering enhanced resistance to chloride corrosion, often referred to as marine grade. Aluminum is another option, valued for its lightweight and corrosion-resistant properties. Aluminum alloys, such as 6063-T6, are commonly used for structural components of cable trays and their fittings. These alloys provide adequate strength while remaining lightweight and non-magnetic, which helps minimize electrical losses. Galvanized steel is frequently used for connecting pieces in environments where moderate corrosion protection is needed. The zinc coating prevents rust and extends the lifespan of the components, and field cuts are often treated with zinc-rich paint to maintain protection.
