

What size is required for the electrical distribution box in a residential building

Modern residential electrical distribution boxes typically require a 200-amp main panel with 40–42 circuit slots to meet NEC standards and accommodate future electrical needs.

Amperage and Capacity

For new residential buildings, the minimum main service panel size is 100 amps, but most modern homes now use 200-amp panels to handle high-draw appliances, HVAC systems, and electric vehicle chargers (NEC 230.79(C), Accio 2026) . A 200-amp panel generally provides 40–42 slots, allowing for sufficient circuits and future expansion . Panels smaller than 100 amps are considered undersized for contemporary homes .

Physical Dimensions and Working Space

The physical size of the panel depends on the number of circuits and manufacturer specifications. Standard residential panels are wall-mounted and designed to fit within typical utility spaces. NEC 110.26 requires a working clearance of at least 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high in front of the panel to ensure safe access . The panel door must open fully to 90°, and the panel should be mounted no higher than 6 feet 7 inches (2 meters) above the floor .
