

What to check in a fiber optic adapter

Insertion Loss Measurement

Insertion loss measures the signal loss when light passes through the adapter. Connect a stable light source to one end of the fiber and an optical power meter to the other. The difference in power readings indicates the insertion loss. Ensure the measured loss is within the acceptable limits for your system to confirm the adapter's quality .

Return Loss Testing

Return loss quantifies the amount of light reflected back toward the source due to imperfections. Use an optical time domain reflectometer (OTDR) or an optical spectrum analyzer (OSA) to measure return loss. High return loss values indicate minimal reflection and better signal quality
