

# Where does the incoming power line to the distribution box run



## Article Overview

The incoming power line runs from the utility service, through a meter, and connects to the main breaker in the distribution box, where it is then distributed to branch circuits.

### Overview of the Incoming Power Path

The incoming power line originates from the utility company, either via overhead lines from a pole or underground through conduit . It first reaches the electric meter, which measures electricity usage for billing purposes . From the meter, the line enters the main distribution box (also called a main panel or breaker box), where it connects to the main circuit breaker or main switch .

### Inside the Distribution Box

Within the distribution box, the incoming phase (live) and neutral wires are connected to the main breaker, which controls the overall power supply to the building . The main breaker feeds busbars, which distribute electricity to individual branch circuit breakers. These branch breakers then supply power to specific circuits, such as lighting, outlets, HVAC systems, or heavy machinery . A neutral bus bar and earth/ground connection ensure safety and proper grounding .
