Cold joints should be inserted at planned locations where concrete pouring is interrupted, typically in slabs, beams, columns, or foundations, with careful attention to load direction and bonding preparation.

Understanding Cold Joints

A cold joint occurs when fresh concrete is poured against partially hardened concrete, creating a weak interface due to incomplete bonding between layers . While generally undesirable, cold joints can be intentionally placed in large pours or staged construction to manage workability and structural sequencing .

Recommended Locations

- **Slabs and Beams:** Cold joints are often inserted along construction lines where pouring must be paused. For slabs, joints are typically placed perpendicular to the main reinforcement and in areas of low tensile stress to minimize structural weakness .
- **Columns and Foundations:** When columns or foundations are poured in stages, cold joints should be horizontal for elements under compression and angled (around 45°) for elements subjected to shear or bending forces .
- **Raft Foundations:** Cold joints in raft foundations should be waterproofed to prevent leakage, especially if exposed to external moisture .

- **Timing:** Avoid delays exceeding 30 minutes between pours to reduce the risk of u...
