Fireproofing Requirements

Cable trays themselves are not always inherently fireproof, but fireproofing is essential in specific scenarios, particularly where trays pass through walls, floors, or electrical shafts, or when they carry critical circuits such as emergency power, fire alarms, or communication lines . Fireproofing helps contain flames, prevent fire propagation along combustible cable insulation, and maintain circuit integrity during a fire .

Methods of Fireproofing

- **Fire-Resistant Trays:** Some trays are manufactured with fireproof coatings or materials, such as fireproof boards, intumescent coatings, or fireproof cotton insulation, to resist high temperatures and maintain structural integrity .
- **Firestopping at Penetrations:** When trays pass through walls or slabs, openings must be sealed with fire-rated materials like firestop packs, mineral wool, or firestop mastic. Large openings may require a fire-resistant backing plate to ensure complete sealing .
- **Protective Coatings and Tapes:** Fire protection solutions, such as FLAMMOTECT-A coatings or DG-CR 0.7 tapes, can be applied to cables within trays to delay flame propagation and maintain functionality during a fire .
