Yes, optical modules often need to be paired to ensure proper communication, especially for wavelength, duplex mode, and fiber type compatibility.

Standard SFP Modules

Standard SFP modules use two fibers: one for transmitting (Tx) and one for receiving (Rx). To establish a successful link, the modules at each end must be matched in wavelength and duplex mode. For example, a 1310nm transceiver must connect to another 1310nm transceiver, and a full-duplex module should pair with another full-duplex module. Mismatched wavelengths or duplex modes can result in link failure or degraded performance. Additionally, the fiber type (multimode or single-mode) must be compatible with both modules to ensure proper transmission .

BiDi SFP Modules

BiDi (Bidirectional) SFP modules are designed to transmit and receive data over a single fiber using different wavelengths for each direction. Because of this, BiDi modules must be used in matched pairs, with one module transmitting at wavelength A and receiving at wavelength B, and the other module doing the opposite. This pairing is essential for the network to function correctly and to take advantage of the single-fiber design .
