Unlike point-to-point cabling, structured systems standardize connections, ensuring each cable has a defined function and location, which is especially important in multi-floor or multi-building environments .

Proper cabling architecture supports high-speed data transmission with minimal signal loss, enabling reliable connectivity for data, voice, and video applications . It ensures low latency, high bandwidth, and consistent network performance, which is critical for bandwidth-intensive operations like video conferencing, cloud computing, and VoIP . By following industry standards such as ANSI/TIA-568, ISO/IEC 11801, and EN 50173, structured cabling guarantees predictable performance and interoperability across devices
