Loose or Damaged Connections: Improperly seated fiber connectors, power cables, or Ethernet connections can prevent the router from establishing a stable link, triggering the red LOS light . 4. Router or ONT Malfunction: Internal hardware or firmware issues in the router or Optical Network Terminal (ONT) can also cause the red light, sometimes intermittently . 5. Environmental Factors: Excessive bending, tight coils, or pressure on the fiber cable (e.g., under skirting boards) can attenuate the signal, leading to intermittent red light flashes .
