- Terminal Blocks and Connectors: Rail-mounted or push-in terminal blocks (like WAGO TOPJOB® S) allow secure connections for solid and stranded conductors, simplifying wiring and ensuring compliance with standards .
- Spring or Half-Loop Clips: Flexible nylon clips that can hold round or flat cables, tubing, or wires, often mounted with screws or push-fit into pre-drilled holes .
- Grounding Clips: Designed to attach grounding wires to the panel or frame, ensuring proper electrical safety .
