- Ensure proper grounding: All metal parts, including the box itself, should be grounded to prevent electric shock .
- Follow local wiring standards: Adhering to electrical codes ensures that the installation is safe and compliant, reducing the risk of faults .
- Inspect connections: Check that all terminals are tight and wires are fully inserted into breakers or terminal blocks to avoid loose connections
