

Wiring method for the main line of the secondary distribution box



Article Overview

The main line of a secondary distribution box is typically wired using a five-wire system: three-phase lines, one neutral, and one protective earth, with careful sequencing and proper connection to breakers and terminal blocks.

Wiring Overview

The incoming main line to a secondary distribution box generally follows a five-wire system: three-phase lines (commonly yellow, green, and red), one neutral line (light blue), and one protective earth line (yellow-green striped) (). The wiring sequence is as follows:

- Three-phase lines (L1, L2, L3): Connect to the main isolating switch or general disconnector of the secondary distribution box ().
- Neutral line (N): Connect to the neutral terminal block, often routed through the leakage protection device before distribution ().
- Protective earth (PE): Connect to the PE terminal block; the PE line should not pass through the leakage protector to avoid unintended tripping ().

Connection Steps

- Main Switch Connection: Lead the three-phase lines from the main isolating switch to the input terminals of the secondary box. Ensure each phase is clearly marked and color-coded ().
- Neutral and PE Wiring: Connect the neutral line to the N terminal of the leakage p...
