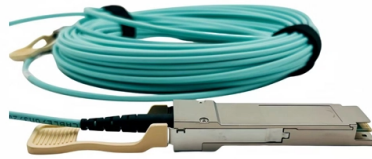


Wiring of household low-voltage distribution boxes

Key Wiring Principles

Voltage Classification and Cable Selection: Low-voltage systems typically operate at 12 V, 24 V, 48 V, or up to 50 V for household applications, including doorbells, thermostats, landscape lighting, and PoE devices . Use insulated cables rated for the specific voltage and current of your system. Twisted-pair cables (Cat5e/6/6A) are common for data and PoE, while coaxial or fiber optic cables are used for video and network distribution . **Distribution Box Layout:** Arrange cables neatly within the box, using separate channels or compartments for power, data, and control circuits to reduce interference and simplify maintenance . Ensure sufficient working space around the box for safe access and future upgrades . **Grounding and Earthing:** Proper grounding is essential to protect both people and equipment. Connect all metallic parts to a low-resistance earth point. This reduces touch voltage, prevents equipment damage from overvoltages, and ensures fuses and breakers operate correctly . Use grounding conductors of appropriate material and size, and follow local electrical codes. **Short-Circuit Protection:** Install circuit breakers or fuses rated for the expected load to prevent overheating and fire hazards . For PoE or other low-voltage circuits, ensure Class 2 or Class 3 power-limited protection is applied according to NEC Article 725 . **Labeling and Safety:** Clearly label all circuits, switches, and terminals to indica...
